

EDITORIAL



TELFOR is the abbreviation for the Telecommunications Forum, a long lasting scientific, engineering and professional event that started in 1993 in Belgrade, Serbia. This year, TELFOR is being organized for the 26th time, what is quite an impressive result for any annual scientific conference. Initial idea was to establish a national scientific conference in Telecommunications. Over years, that idea has evolved in such a way that today TELFOR is a huge regional international conference in Telecommunications and Information Technologies, having also its several other parallel tracks, like special presentations of companies, presentations and papers of invited experts, exhibition of telecommunications hardware, software, systems and services, then seminars, tutorials, round tables, etc. During TELFOR's existence several thousand of scientific papers were presented and published, quite a number of them being of a considerable quality and with important results. **Having such resources at disposal, establishing a scientific journal, the TELFOR Journal, was a very natural next step** for several reasons:

- Authors with favorable TELFOR reviewers' assessments would have an additional opportunity to improve and expand their initial ideas;
- Editorial board would have a wide set of prospective invited authors;
- After some time of existence, one could expect that TELFOR Journal would attract independent authors to submit their papers to be considered for publishing.

The history of TELFOR Journal is now ten years long. The first volume consisting of two issues was published during the TELFOR 2009 conference in November 2009. That first volume of the Journal was intended to present a selection of the improved and expanded versions of the best scientific papers presented at Telecommunications Forum 2008.

The second volume of the TELFOR Journal, again with two issues, was electronically published before the TELFOR 2010 conference, in November 2010. Printed copies were realized slightly later.

The third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth and ninth volume of the TELFOR Journal, in both electronic and printed versions, were published before the TELFOR 2011 - TELFOR 2017 conferences, respectively. Printed copies were realized with a significantly improved color quality and increased number of copies, depending on our sponsors support. Up to now, 214 thoroughly reviewed scientific papers were published from the first up to the ninth TELFOR Journal. Taking into account the just appearing Volume X with 24 published papers, during all ten years in TELFOR Journal were published 238 scientific papers, almost 24 papers per year on the average. Apart from authors from Serbia, authors from many other European and non-European countries were also present.

The TELFOR Journal is an OPEN ACCESS journal with no charge for authors and readers.

This is the Jubilee tenth volume of TELFOR Journal, based on the selected, expanded and improved results from the TELFOR 2017 conference. Some editorial program improvements and Journal content WEB visibilities ("Online First") were also recently introduced.

After ten years of existence one can easily conclude that TELFOR Journal is already a recognizable scientific publication in the region of South-East Europe. According to Serbian state and civil scientific authorities, TELFOR Journal got in 2014 a considerably better formal recognition. Starting with 2014 all published Journal papers got DOI. The impressions of the scientific and research community were also very positive, both with respect to the Journal scientific quality and the very nice design. TELFOR Journal is indexed in several well recognized index bases: **Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), Google Scholar, SCOPUS (from 2016), National Library of Serbia Repository, Serbian Citation Index (Sci Index), ...** TELFOR Journal has been submitted for evaluation in Clarivate Analytics ESCI list.

The TELFOR Journal is published in the English language, with both electronic and printed versions, minimally with two issues per year. It is an IEEE co-supported publication, following all the IEEE rules, procedures and consequently the scientific quality.

The large spectrum of TELFOR Journal topics accounts for the rapid convergence through telecommunications towards the information and knowledge-based society. The Journal provides a medium for exchanging research results and technological achievements accomplished by the scientific community from academia and industry.
